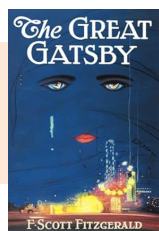
**JAN 11** **Disinformation, Discord, and Story:** A Conversation with **David Quammen** and **Betsy Gaines Quammen**.
