Sun Valley Winter Sports Hall of Fame FAQ

Who should be nominated for the SVWSHOF?



A strong nominee has made significant contributions to a winter sport over many

years and has also given back to the local Sun Valley area community. This can include, but is not limited to, professional sporting success at the local, national, or international level, contributions to the growth and development of their sport, or supporting new and established athletes at various levels of athletics. Athletic achievements and local contributions to the sport are given equal consideration in the selection process.

Does the nominee have to be from the Sun Valley area?

The nominee should have strong ties to the Sun Valley area, whether they are from here, are long-time residents, or have made significant contributions to the Sun Valley winter sports community.

Does the nominee need to be a professional athlete?

No! While many inductees have had successful professional athletic careers, just as many have been involved as coaches, supporters, technological innovators, organization founders, and in many more facets of winter sports. There are many ways that people contribute to the winter sports community.

Can I nominate a pair or a group of people?

Yes, nominations can be for individuals or for closely connected groups of people, such as sports teams, performing groups, couples, etc.

How much detail should be included on the nomination form?

As much detail as you can offer! The more fully we understand the nominee's accomplishments, the better their nomination can be evaluated for induction to the Hall of Fame. If there is not enough space on the nomination form to list everything, feel free to attach additional pages of information, articles about the nominee, photos, etc. Providing extra information is highly encouraged!

Can I nominate someone who has been nominated before?

Yes! Previous nominations do not exclude someone from being nominated again. Concurrent nominations for the same nominee will be combined into one entry.
